- Describe common behavior, conditions, and situations associated with active shooters
- Educate participants on the expectations of primary response agency(ies) to active shooter events
- Foster communication between key stakeholders and local emergency response teams. This workshop includes discussions of interoperability, communications protocols, and best practices for planning assumptions, preparedness, and response.

Building Emergency Planning Capabilities

The event will also describe how to incorporate key elements of successful incident management into planning efforts including:

- Communication and incident planning for employees
- Emergency action plan development
- Coordinating with first responders
