**Name:** L950 All-Hazards Incident Commander

**Description:** This course is designed to provide local and state-level emergency responders with a robust understanding of the duties, responsibilities, and capabilities of an effective Incident Commander (IC) on an All-Hazards Incident Management Team (AHIMT). These responsibilities fall into two categories: 1) responding to the incident and the command needs of the incident, and 2) effectively fulfilling the position responsibilities of an Incident Commander on an All-Hazards IMT.

Target audience: Includes Emergency Management Officials, Fire Service, Law Enforcement, Hospital Staff, Emergency Medical Services

**Pre-Requisites:** Personnel must have completed the following ICS courses or an equivalent to these courses: ICS-100, ICS-200, ICS-300, ICS-400, IS-700, and IS-800. *These course certificates must be uploaded to your SERT TRAC account at least 2 weeks before the course start date to be approved to attend this training.*
