

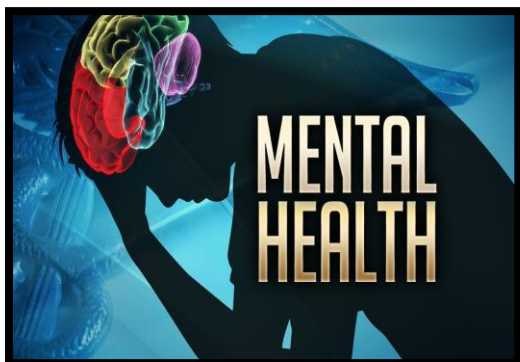
PLUGGED IN SPEAKER SERIES: WORKING WITH DIFFICULT PEOPLE DURING DISASTERS
